The EuroScience Open Forum is a biennial, pan-European, general science conference dedicated to scientific research and innovation. Each conference aims to deliver stimulating content and lively debate around the latest advancements and discoveries in the sciences, humanities and social sciences. ESOF brings together over 4,500 leading scientists, thinkers, innovators, early careers researchers, business people, policymakers, science and technology communicators, journalists and educators from more than 90 countries, to discuss current and future breakthroughs in contemporary science.

The Science in the City Festival is an important feature of every edition, dedicated to people of all ages who are curious about science and technology. It is one of the largest public engagement in science and technology events in Europe. The Festival will host international performers and will be multi-lingual, engaging numerous participants coming from all over the world.

Both Ways — A Dialogue between Art and Science

Five pairs of art curators and science communicators, from five countries in South-East Europe, reflect on how art and science contribute, in different ways, to the production of knowledge. The name *Both Ways* was designed to highlight a multicenter review of contemporary art & science scene which integrates only apparently distant ways of thinking and different methods. The projects will be connected in both a material and in an immaterial way in the Science in the City Festival.

Participating institutions are Ludwig Museum from Budapest, Hungary; Cluj Cultural Center with Scientifica Science Center from Cluj-Napoca; Romania; Academy of Applied Arts and Rijeka Science Festival, Croatia; Trieste Contemporanea, Italy; and Center for the Promotion of Science, Serbia. Behind the initiative are standing Central European Initiative (CEI) and International Trieste Foundation (FIT), with logistical support provided by Trieste Contemporanea.
