













Future Art and Science Industrial Heritage (FASIH)

is a regional initiative based on the interdisciplinary artistic and scientific research and assessment of the industrial and cultural heritage in Southeast Europe. Project FASIH detects, evaluates and revitalises architectural achievements and immaterial cultural processes that have marked the modern history of the three cities: Belgrade (Serbia), Rijeka (Croatia) and Trbovlje (Slovenia). By using new technologies and innovative art-science practices, the project provides a new approach to safeguarding and promoting the industrial objects of shared multicultural history of the region.

Main project outcomes will be:

- two reports on the status of industrial heritage, and on the scientific advancement and sustainability
- · learning/training methodology
- the production of nine interdisciplinary art-science projects
- three exhibitions one in each of the three cities during the first half of 2025
- · catalogues of productions and exhibitions
- final conference in Rijeka in mid 2025
